Incident Narrative

On April 26, 2011 at approximately 5:01 P.M. the Washington Township Police Department received a call of a burglary in progress to a residence located on Glen Ct., Turnersville, NJ. A witness reported seeing a male subject later identified as Michael J. Ferringo wearing gloves and acting suspicious. The witness observed him remove the screen to a window and force his way into a neighbor's residence. The subject then was observed climbing into the residence through the window. Officers arrived on scene just after the suspect exited the residence through the same window. He then attempted to discard his gloves and fled from the officers but was apprehended after a brief foot chase. He was subsequently charged with burglary, and obstruction of justice and his bail was set at \$5000.00 full cash bail. He was then lodged in the Gloucester County Jail after failing to post his bail.

This investigation is a great example of the community helping law enforcement and contacting us when observing suspicious activity. We continue to ask for any help the public can provide us in fighting crime within the township.
