Incident Narrative

On Monday March 23, 2010; three days following the most recent Wal-Mart arrest, the Washington Township Police Department received a call from the Turnersville Wal-Mart store regarding a previous recorded incident involving a similar situation of where a racially based remark was broadcasted over the store's paging system. Reports indicate that this incident had taken place back on December 28, 2009 at approximately 10:27 p.m. The incident was reported to Wal-Mart management but police were never contacted. Subsequent investigation revealed that the individual involved with the December incident is the same person responsible for the March 14th incident. Charges will result in two counts of harassment and bias intimidation. The case will be heard in Atlantic County.
