HIRING PROCESS ANNOUNCEMENT

The Washington Township Police Department will be conducting an entrance examination for the positions of **Police Officer** and **Special Law Enforcement Officer Class II**. Candidates must meet all eligibility requirements in order to participate.

The Washington Township Police Department **will not** be sponsoring candidates through police academy training, therefore if a candidate is taking this written examination without a current New Jersey Police Training Commission certification, they must be in a position where they will be certified for the position sought. Examples of this situation include:

- Those candidates who are currently enrolled in the appropriate New Jersey Police Training Commission course, will be certified by **July 31, 2010** and meet all other eligibility requirements once the certificate is received; or
- Those candidates who will be enrolled in the appropriate New Jersey Police Training Commission course, will be certified by **July 31, 2010** and meet all other eligibility requirements once the certificate is received.

A \$40.00 entrance fee is required to cover the cost of the testing materials. The entrance fee must be paid in the form of a bank issued check made out to the "Township of Washington". The first phase (written test) will take place on August 22, 2009 at 10:00 AM. The test will be conducted at the Washington Township High School, 9/10 Wing Cafeteria, 529 Hurffville-Cross Keys Road, Sewell, New Jersey 08080.

All candidates must submit a copy of their current resume, proof of college requirements and/or appropriate military documentation, and a copy of their valid New Jersey Driver's License. All proofs and entrance fee must be submitted to:
