Incident Narrative

On December 10, 2011 the Washington Township Police Department responded to the parking lot of the Boston Market Store for a report of a carjacking that had just occurred. The victim in this incident reported that he was sitting in his vehicle in the parking lot when he was approached by a white male subject who ordered him out of his vehicle. The victim refused to get out of his vehicle and an altercation took place between him and the suspect. The suspect was able to get into the vehicle during the struggle and left the area heading northbound on S.H. 42. The vehicle was located a short time later in Philadelphia, PA with the assistance of the vehicle's On-Star system. The following is the description of the suspect in this investigation:

- White Male in his 30's with a fair complexion, having grayish blond hair, scruffy facial hair, and being approximately 5'7" tall and weighing approximately 180 lbs. The suspect was wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt at the time and had a paper bag in his hand.
