### Incident Narrative

On 04-14-11 at approximately 10:51 A.M. the Washington Township Police Department was advised of a burglary in progress on Saturn Dr., Sewell, New Jersey. A resident who was home observed the suspect identified as James G. Richardson attempting to gain entry into his residence after he had knocked on the front door. The suspect proceeded to a sunroom and was in the process of cutting open a screen to a downstairs window to enter the main portion of the home. The resident immediately called the Washington Township Police Department and officers responded to the scene. After seeing the officers the suspect began to run through several properties attempting to elude officers but he was eventually taken into custody without further incident. He was charged with burglary, trespassing, criminal mischief and resisting arrest. His bail was set at \$20,000.00 full cash and he was lodged in the Gloucester County Jail in default of bail.

This investigation is currently on-going and residents are asked to be observant in their neighborhoods for any suspicious activity. Residents are asked to report suspicious activity at 856-256-1212 or 911 in emergencies. The community is another set of eyes and ears for the police department and of great value in solving these types of crimes.
