Incident Narrative

On Monday 6-8-09 at approx. 1658 hours Gloucester County Communications advised that Pitman Police Department was pursuing a stolen vehicle into Washington Township. The suspect vehicle then drove through a highway construction work zone located on State Highway 47 when the vehicle became disabled. Two white male suspects exited the vehicle and fled on foot into a nearby residential area of Washington Township off of Chapel Heights Road. While fleeing one of the two suspects entered into the garage of nearby residence and forcibly took the vehicle from a woman who was just returning home from work. Several officers and police K-9's from neighboring towns searched the area but were unable to find the suspects.
