

2011 Washington Township Police Department K9 Fund Donation Drive

The Washington Township Police Department maintains a Police K9 Program that is fully-funded from community donations. Re-established in 2006, this program has grown to include five Police K9s assisting in the apprehension of suspects, the locating of concealed illegal drugs, and locating materials involved in arson and explosive incidents, as well as other policing activities.

In order to continue funding of this program, the department is soliciting donations from the community to offset annual expenses required to sustain Police K9 operations. This year, the department is selling a 2011 Washington Township Police K9 calendar full of color photographs of each K9 while involved in their day-to-day activities. All proceeds from the sale of the calendars will be used to replenish the K9 program fund. Each 2011 calendar costs **\$10.00** (not including shipping and handling) and is available through Chief Rafael Muniz's office.
