Incident Narrative

On Sunday May 9, 2010 two armed robberies occurred at Washington Township gas stations. Police first responded (10:05 am) to the Shell gas station at 6001 Black Horse Pike gas station where a suspect approached the gas attendant with a knife and demanded money. The suspect fled the scene with approximately \$35.00 cash and ran into nearby wooded area. At approximately 11:35 am a second robbery occurred at the Xtra gas station (684 Delsea Drive) where the suspect fitting the same description approached the attendant with a knife and demanded money. The gas attendant ran from the suspect while the suspect entered a vehicle and fled the scene. Several minutes after fleeing the scene, the suspect abandoned his vehicle and was apprehended without incident by Washington Township Police while walking through the Shop Rite parking lot located in Glassboro. Police charged 19 y/o Phillip Murphy of Sewell N.J. with two counts of armed robbery and one count of terroristic threats and was remanded to the Gloucester County Jail in lieu of 50,000 full cash bail.
