PUBLIC SAFETY NOTICE

On January 15, 2010 at approximately 1200 p.m. bomb threats were made towards the Washington Township High School and Bunker Hill Middle Schools. A multi-agency response involving the Washington Township Fire Department, Washington Township Ambulance, Washington Township Police Department, and the Render Safe Task Force (multiple explosive detection K-9 teams) was coordinated.

Please be aware that incidents of this magnitude will be thoroughly investigated by all agencies involved as these crimes are minimally categorized as 3rd degree crimes in New Jersey receiving between 3-5 year prison term as well as civil penalties of not less than \$2000 or actual costs incurred by or resulting from the law enforcement and emergency services response to the false alarm, whichever is higher.

After a thorough investigation and subsequent clearing of both locations it has been determined that both the Washington Township High School and the Bunker Hill Middle Schools are declared safe at this time.

The Washington Township Police Department will continue to vigorously patrol the area of the Washington Township High School before, during, and after all scheduled activities.
